Financial Reports/

Contribution Review: John Falduto and Tom Sawyer from Sawyer Falduto Asset Management distributed and provided an overview of the December 31, 2012 Quarterly Investment Performance Report. For the quarter ending December 31, 2012 the fund had a total return of +0.83% (gross of fee) as compared to the account benchmark return of +0.34%. For the calendar year ended December 31, 2012 the total return for the portfolio is +10.34% as compared to the benchmark at +8.53%. As of December 31, 2012 the Plan Net held in Trust for Pension Benefits is \$55,221,210.48.

After a review of the December 31, 2012 Quarterly Investment Performance Report Trustee Rounsfull motioned to accept the December 31, 2012 Quarterly Investment Performance Report, Trustee Dvorak seconded and a roll call was taken and the vote was all ayes, no nays and the motion passed.
