RESOLUTION NO. 18-87

- **WHEREAS**, the Village of Glenview (the "Village") is a home-rule municipality located in Cook County, Illinois;
- WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, County, City or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, being Chapter 820 ILCS 130/0.01, et. seq. (the "Prevailing Wage Act");
- WHEREAS, the Prevailing Wage Act requires that the Village ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of the Village employed in performing construction of public works, for the Village; and
- WHEREAS, the corporate authorities have determined that the Village is obligated to comply with the mandates of the Prevailing Wage Act.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glenview, as follows:
- SECTION 1: To the extent and as required by the Prevailing Wage Act, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in the construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Village is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Cook County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of September 1, 2017. A copy of that determination is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms appearing in this Resolution, which are also used in the Prevailing Wage Act, shall be the same as in said Act.
- <u>SECTION 2:</u> Nothing herein shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works and landscaping construction of the Village to the extent required by the Prevailing Wage Act.
- **SECTION 3:** The Village Clerk shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Village this determination of such prevailing rate of wage.
- **SECTION 4:** The Village shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed, or file their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.
- **SECTION 5:** The Village shall promptly file a certified copy of this Resolution with both the Secretary of State Index Division and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 6: The Village Clerk shall cause a notice to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area that the determination of prevailing wages has been made. Said notice shall conform substantially to the notice attached hereto. Such publication shall constitute notice that this is the determination of the Village and is effective.
