New Parking Lot Lights will be over 4 Stories above the Lake

- On a hill 26 feet above the lake
- With 20-foot poles
- With 4-foot mounting
- 90-degree Angle with 5000K
 - Noah and I discussed 4000K
- Shields on 3 sides
- Headlights from cars parking north of the shed



Pickleball Court Lights will be ~
5 stories above the lake

- On 26-foot hill
 - With 20-foot pole
 - With 4-foot mounting
 - 90-degree angle
 - 5000 Kelvins

Has some shielding

- Back shields
