## Glenview Road Construction Bulletin Number 2

The Illinois Dept. of Transportation (IDOT) has advised the Village that effective Monday morning, June 18, 1990, the section of Glenview Rd. between Wagner Rd. and Harms Rd. will be closed to through traffic. This closure is necessary to allow for the installation of the water main and storm sewer in this tightly restricted right of way and to prepare for the demolition of the bridge over the North Branch of the Chicago River. It is now estimated that this closure will be in effect for approximately six weeks but could last longer if bad weather or unforeseen conditions are encountered. Those residents living west of the river and east of Wagner Rd. will have local access to the west only.

The Village and IDOT are in the process of contacting the local bus companies, PACE, NORTRAN, the garbage collection companies, recycling company, etc. about the impending closure. Additional signs to warn the non-residents who utilize Glenview Rd. have also been posted.

While every effort will be made to ensure that the work area is barricaded safely at night, residents are asked to eliminate any pedestrian traffic in the area.

Parents should also warn their children that a construction site is not a playground.

The Village has set up a dedicated phone number to specifically handle calls concerning the Glenview Rd. project. That number is 724-0003. It will be staffed from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday with an answering machine available for after hours questions. Calls will then be returned on the next working day. Of course if emergency situations arise in the evenings or on the weekends, residents are advised to call the Glenview Police or Fire Depts. whichever is more appropriate, and they will evaluate the situation and contact the appropriate agency.

During the timeframe of the Road Closure the Fire Dept. will be activating their temporary fire station on Harms Rd. in the Cook County Forest Preserve District Forestry Division Headquarters in order to ensure the prompt availability of emergency fire and medical services.
