Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 7:08 p.m.

Roll Call: Chairman Cho and Commissioner Milan

Absent: Commissioner Hogan

Chairman Cho made a motion to approve the meeting minutes as presented from the August 22, 2017 meeting. Commissioner Milan seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

At 7:10 p.m. Chairman Cho made a motion to enter into executive session for the purpose of discussing the appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance, or dismissal of specific employees of the Village.

Commissioner Milan seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

The Board resumed the Special Meeting at 8:55 p.m.

Commissioner Milan made a motion to pass Michael Tomsovic and Brian Tierney for the purpose of the background investigation component for the position of Firefighter/Paramedic. Chairman Cho seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Milan made a motion to conditionally pass Owen Yanz for the purpose of the background investigation component for the position of Firefighter/Paramedic, pending further information from the Darien Woodridge Fire Department; and delegated final decision making authority to Chief Ensign. Chairman Cho seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Milan made a motion to remove Jason Wisnewski from further consideration for the position for Firefighter/Paramedic due to his lack of experience. Chairman Cho seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Milan made a motion to remove David Conrad from further consideration for the position of Firefighter/Paramedic due to his underlying conduct and the results of the background investigation. Chairman Cho seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

Chairman Cho made a motion to adjourn the Special Meeting at 8:55 p.m., which was seconded by Chairman Milan and was unanimously approved.
